**AMENDMENT #4
TO MEDICAL/SURGICAL SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION AND
JUST-IN-TIME (JIT) INVENTORY MANAGEMENT CONTRACT**

This Fourth Amendment (the “Amendment”) to the Medical/Surgical Supply Distribution and Just-In-Time (JIT) Inventory Management contract is between Medline Industries LP, an Illinois limited partnership, (and for sales involving the state of Tennessee, Medline Industries Holdings, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership) (collectively, “Contractor”) and **San Bernardino County**, (the “County” or “Provider” and sometimes referred to herein individually as a “Party” and collectively with Contractor, as the “Parties”) is made and entered into August 4, 2026 (“Amendment Effective Date”).

WHEREAS, Contractor and County are Parties to the Medical/Surgical Supply Distribution and Just-In-Time (JIT) Inventory Management contract with an effective date of October 26, 2021 (the “Contract”).

WHEREAS, Contractor and County desire to modify the terms of the Contract, as previously amended on July 11, 2023 and January 13, 2026 (the Contract and all executed amendments collectively referred to as the “Contract”).

ACCORDINGLY, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Amendment, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. Due to a typographical error, **Section 5, Product Rebate**, incorrectly lists the dates for which the County’s Net Sales will be assessed for the purposes of calculating the applicable rebate. The dates in the Product Rebate of the Contract are corrected as follows:

This rebate shall be based on the Net Sales growth from December 1, 2025, through May 31, 2026.

2. **Delete Section 8, Termination** in its entirety.
3. All other terms of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect. If the terms of the Contract in any way conflict with or are otherwise inconsistent with the terms of this Amendment, this Amendment shall govern and control.
4. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same Amendment. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Amendment (whether by facsimile, PDF or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Amendment upon request.
