Tuesday,	the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors
adopted an ordinance relating	to the addition of Chapter 16 to Division 7 of Title 2
of the San Bernardino County	Code.

Ordinance Summary

This ordinance added Chapter 16: Unlawful Possession of a Catalytic Converter to Division 7 of Title 2 of the San Bernardino County Code. This ordinance declares it to be unlawful to possess a catalytic converter that is not attached to a vehicle unless the person has valid proof of ownership of the catalytic converter, subject to stated exceptions. The ordinance further makes it unlawful for any person to knowingly falsify or cause to be falsified any information in a record intended to show valid proof of ownership. Violations of the ordinance are punishable as a misdemeanor with a fine not exceeding \$1,000, imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding six months, or both.
