INTRODUCTION

- Fulfill the noticing process required under Proposition 218 to extend the continued use of the current annual rate adjustment methodology and amend exhibits for the Solid Waste Handling Franchise Agreements for County Franchise Areas (CFA) 17 and 21.
- Amend Solid Waste Handling Franchise Agreement for CFA 16 to allow subcontracting of services and revise exhibits.

CFA 17 & 21

RENEWAL OF THE ANNUAL RATE ADJUSTMENT METHODOLOGY

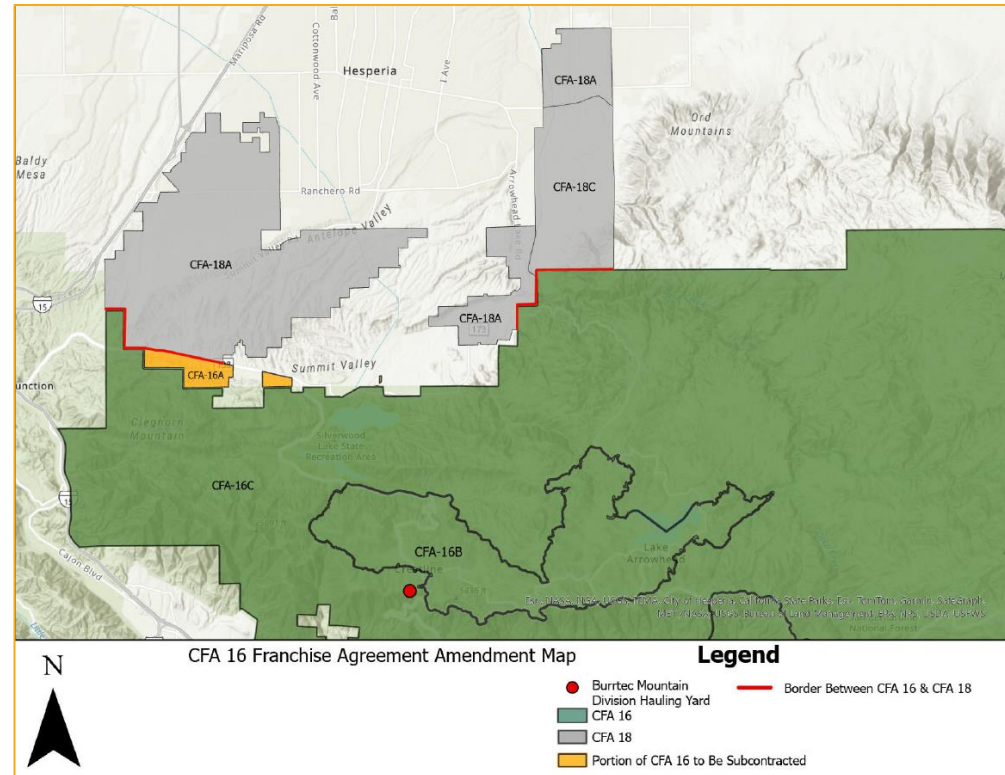
- Under California Government Code Section 53756, agencies providing refuse collection can implement automatic charge adjustments for up to five years.
- The renewal of the Proposition 218 notices would extend the use of the annual rate adjustment methodology in CFA 17 (Fawnskin area) and CFA 21 (Trona and Red Mountain), for another five years, starting July 1, 2025 to July 1, 2029.
- The current rate methodology for CFA 17 and 21 has been in effect since July 1, 2020 and is scheduled to expire on July 1, 2024.
- Proposition 218 notices were sent out on February 21, 2025, giving residents 45 days to protest the renewal of the rate adjustment methodology.
- 0 valid protests received as of Friday, April 4, 2025.

CFA 16 AMENDMENT (CRESTLINE, RUNNING SPRINGS, LAKE ARROWHEAD, SUMMIT VALLEY, AND SURROUNDING AREAS) SUBCONTRACTING SERVICES

In order to optimize efficiency, the proposed amendment to CFA 16 would permit Mountain Disposal Services, Inc., to subcontract solid waste handling services for Zone A (unincorporated Summit Valley, orange highlighted area on the map), with the nearby hauler for CFA 18, Advance Disposal.

Zone A **does not qualify** for a state-issued waiver.

Zone B and C (green area on the map) **qualify** for state-issued waivers.





CFA 16 AMENDMENT NEXT STEPS

- Customers will continue to be billed by Mountain Disposal, at the same Board-approved rates.
- Implementation of services by a subcontracted hauler may begin as early as July 1, 2025.
