1. ITEM NO. 1: LAST DAY TO SUBMIT QUESTIONS

Contractors are advised of the following change as it appears within Section A., Bidding Requirements, Instructions to Bidders of the Specifications:

Should any of the questions require changes to the specifications or requirements, an addendum will be issued to clarify those changes. Bidders shall be responsible for ensuring that they have received all addendums issued by the Department and the submittal of a bid shall be deemed to be based on the Bid Documents, as modified and/or clarified by any and all addenda.

Contractors are advised of the following change as it appears within Section A., Bidding Requirements, Instructions to Bidders of the Specifications

- A. Contractors are advised that Item 8, Interpretation of Drawings and Specifications in the Instructions to Bidders section of the bid package issued on December 29, 2025 (as amended) shall be replaced with:

If any bidder is in doubt as to the true meaning of any requirements of drawings or specifications, or finds any discrepancies in, or omissions from the drawings or specifications, the bidder may submit to the engineer a written request for an interpretation or correction

thereof. The written request must be received by **Thursday, February 26, 2026**. The person making the request will be responsible for its prompt delivery. Interpretations or corrections will be made only by addenda to specifications or by dated revisions or drawings with a copy of each addition or change being furnished through the district to each prospective bidder. Only a written interpretation or correction by Addendum shall be binding.

2. ITEM NO. 2: BID OPENING DATE

Contractors are advised of the following change as it appears within Section A., Bidding Requirements, Instructions to Bidders of the Specifications:

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Public Works – Special Districts (Department), on behalf of the Board of Supervisors for San Bernardino County Service Area 70J-Oak Hills (District), will receive sealed bids for the CSA 70 GH – LYTLE CREEK NORTH SCUM SKIMMER PROJECT on or before March 5, 2026 at 2pm at their office at 222 W. Hospitality Lane, 2nd Floor, San Bernardino, California, 92415-0450, at which time the bids will be opened VIRTUALLY VIA GO TO MEETING, Bids received after this time will be returned unopened. Bids shall be valid for 60 calendar days after the bid opening date.

3. BIDDER QUESTIONS

Question 1: Rotating Pipe Skimmer in the rectangular clarifier basin. Is this going to be replaced with new? The unit looked in good shape when we were out there and may only need maintenance.

Answer: Procurement of new equipment is not mandatory. Existing equipment may be assessed and reused if it is determined to be in satisfactory operating condition.

Question 2: Are there AS BUILT drawings available for the rectangular Clarifier or the oxidation Ditch and Rotors?

Answer: There is no complete as-built drawing set available for this project; however, a 90% set is available and has been provided for reference.

The above items modify the formal bid documents in the manner prescribed and in that manner only. All other contract items will remain as originally intended. Contractor will sign/date this addendum and submit with their bid as acknowledgement of receiving and complying with this addendum.
