IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO CONTRACT NO. 23-615, entered by and between the San Bernardino County (County) on behalf of the Workforce Development Department (WDD) and First Institute Training & Management, Inc. (Contractor). County and Contractor are collectively referred as "Parties."

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into Contract No. 23-615 on July 1, 2023 for the delivery of the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Youth Employment Program (CYEP), and

WHEREAS, the original term of the Contract commenced on July 1, 2023 and expired on June 30, 2024, and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2024, the Parties entered into Amendment No. 1 to extend the term of the Contract through June 30, 2025 and increase the aggregate amount not-to-exceed compensation by \$5,234,505 to an aggregate maximum obligation amount of \$6,630,373, and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the term of the Contract through June 30, 2026, the aggregate amount not-to-exceed compensation shall remain unchanged, and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants and conditions, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Section D is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

This Contract is effective as of July 1, 2023, and expires June 30, 2026, but may be terminated earlier in accordance with provisions of this Contract. The Parties may extend this Contract for two one-year period(s) contingent upon Contractor performance and the availability of funding from the aforementioned state and/or federal funds, which extension shall be memorialized in writing signed by both Parties.

2. The parties agree that this Amendment No. 2 may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but both of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument, and that a photocopy or facsimile may serve as an original. If this Amendment No. 2 is executed in counterparts, no signatory hereto shall be bound until both the parties have fully executed a counterpart of this Amendment No. 2. The Parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Amendment No. 2 (whether by facsimile, PDF, or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each Party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Amendment No. 2 upon request.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain unchanged.

On June 25, 2024, the Board (Item No. 119), the Board approved Amendment No. 1 to the contracts, revising enrollment numbers, increasing the aggregate contract amount by \$5,234,505, from \$1,395,505 to \$6,630,373, extending the term by one year, for a contract period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025, and delegating the authority to the Workforce Development Department Director to execute amendments to extend the term of these contracts for a maximum of three consecutive one-year periods, subject to review by County Counsel.
