## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-60**

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DETERMINING THERE WILL BE NO PROPERTY TAX REVENUE AMOUNTS TO BE EXCHANGED BETWEEN AND AMONG SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, THE BARSTOW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES RESULTING FROM THE JURISDICTIONAL CHANGE DESCRIBED BY LAFCO 3271

On Tuesday March 11, 2025, on motion of Supervisor Hagman, duly seconded by Supervisor Baca, Jr., and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County hereby finds and determines that:

- A. Pursuant to Section 99 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Filing by the Local Agency Formation Commission Executive Officer, the governing bodies of all local agencies whose service responsibilities will be altered by change of organization shall negotiate and determine by resolution the amount of property tax revenues to be exchanged between and among such local agencies.
- B. Except as provided in Section 99.01 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, in the event that a jurisdictional change would affect the service area or service responsibility of one or more special districts, the Board of Supervisors shall, on behalf of all special districts, negotiate any exchange of property tax revenues.
- C. The Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County has determined that there will be no exchange of property tax revenues as a result of the following jurisdictional change:

LAFCO 3271 – ANNEXATION TO THE BARSTOW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (ASSESSOR PARCEL NUMBERS 0424-081-16, 0424-081-17, 0424-081-74 (portion), 0424-081-75, 0424-152-02, 0424-152-03, 0424-191-01, 0424-191-02, 0424-191-03, 0424-191-04, and 0424-191-05)

**SECTION 2.** The Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County hereby resolves and orders that:

- A. The jurisdictional change does not require any exchange of property tax revenue. The revenue distribution will remain as reflected in Exhibit A.
- B. The annual tax increment generated in the areas subject to the jurisdictional change will not be altered by the proposed jurisdictional change.

**SECTION 3.** The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to certify the passage of this resolution and to cause a certified copy to be sent to the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Bernardino County.
