#### RECOMMENDATION(S)

- 1. Approve Board of Supervisors Discretionary Fund District Specific Priorities Program of \$20,000,000 for community projects over an approximately four-year period, from September 21, 2021 through December 31, 2025, and permit approval of quarterly allocations through the quarterly budget adjustment process.
- 2. Authorize the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector to post the necessary budget adjustments to the 2021-22 budget, as detailed in the Financial Impact section. (Four Votes Required)

**Promote the Countywide Vision.**

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this item will result in the use of Discretionary General Funding (Net County Cost). The \$20 million in funding for the Board of Supervisors (Board) Discretionary Fund - District Specific Priorities Program (Priorities Program) will help the Board engage in projects to assist communities and County citizens and will be allocated equally to each of the five Board Districts. On an annual basis, unspent appropriations for discretionary funding will be carried over into the subsequent year's budget. Following adoption of the budget and discretionary appropriation, Priorities Program projects must be presented to the full Board for approval.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

It is the policy of the Board to work with community partners through County services and contractual agreements to identify programs, projects, and initiatives, that support the mission of San Bernardino County, and to provide services to citizens that promote health, safety, economic well-being, education, recreation, and other public services that enhance quality of life, and meet the needs of the County's citizens. Through the use of the Priorities Program, and in conjunction with various community programs, the Board may provide assistance for projects or initiatives that support the County's and CEO's goals and objectives. The term of the Priorities Program shall be over an approximately four-year period, from September 21, 2021 through December 31, 2025.

Board discretionary funding allocations under the Priorities Program are non-competitive and must be for projects or services of \$50,000 or more. Contracts shall be paid on a reimbursable basis or under other terms which provide adequate controls as approved by the Board.

An additional five percent (5%) shall be applied to the cost of each allocation of Board discretionary funds allocated to third party (non-County or non-Board-Governed) entities and will be distributed to the department/agency that administers the payment of Board discretionary fund allocations to cover staffing and other administrative costs incurred in the administration of this program.
