SECOND AMENDMENT

CHILD WELFARE COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Section 2.2 of their January 1, 2023 Child Welfare Collaboration Agreement, as amended (Agreement), Casey Family Programs (CFP) and San Bernadino County Children and Family Services (CFS) enter into this Second Amendment to the Agreement, effective January 1, 2025 (Second Amendment). - 3. Agreement otherwise in full force and effect. Except as specifically set forth herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
