### IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

It is hereby agreed to amend Contract No. 24-951, as follows:

#### SECTION I. DEFINITIONS

**Add Paragraph P to read as follows:**

- P. Community Based Organizations (CBOs) – Local, nonprofit entities that aim to improve the wellbeing of residents within a specific geographical area. They often address local needs and work to connect people with resources and services.

#### SECTION II. FOUNDATION SERVICE RESPONSIBILITIES

**Paragraph A is amended to read as follows:**

- A. Establish subrecipient agreements with California Community Colleges Fresh Success Providers and Community Based Organizations (CBOs) approved by TAD to offer CalFresh E&T services to County residents. Foundation shall notify TAD in writing of all Fresh Success Providers that will be included in the Fresh Success E&T Plan for state and federal approval and that intend to offer E&T services to County clients. Agreements are executed as subawards under the Foundation's primary contract with CDSS and incorporate any flow down provisions required by TAD under this agreement.

**Paragraph B.1 is amended to read as follows:**

B.1. Identify and assess potential E&T participants enrolled in the community college or a CBO, and if the participant is an E&T eligible CalFresh recipient, enroll them into Fresh Success E&T Program.

**All other terms and conditions of Contract No. 24-951 remain in full force and effect.**

This Contract may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same Contract. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Contract (whether by facsimile, PDF, or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Contract upon request.
