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ORDINANCE NO. SD 23-____

An ordinance of the Bloomington Recreation and Park District to adopt by reference Sections 52.0130, 53.0603, 53.0604, 53.0605, 53.0606, and 53.0607 of the San Bernardino County Code and add new regulations relating to electric vehicle charging station fees and time limits for District parking lots.

Be it ordained by the Board of Directors of the Bloomington Recreation and Park District, County of San Bernardino, State of California, as follows:

SECTION 1. The following San Bernardino County Code Sections are hereby adopted by reference for the regulation of District owned or maintained parking lots:

- (A) Section 52.0130 Penalty
- (B) Section 53.0603 Control Devices and Equipment, and Marking of Stalls
- (C) Section 53.0604 Parking Regulations
- (D) Section 53.0605 Speed Limit
- (E) Section 53.0606 Classification of Offenses and Penalties
- (F) Section 53.0607 Removal or Towing of Vehicles

SECTION 2. The following new regulations are hereby adopted to apply to District owned or maintained parking lots:

(A) Electric Vehicle Fees and Time Limits

(1) The Electric Vehicles (EVs) charging station monitors shall display the schedule of fees and time limits, if any, established by the Board of Directors. As a convenience to vehicle owners, the applicable fee, if any, may be displayed on the EV charging station application.

(2) EV charging stations are intended for EVs and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEVs) that need to be charged. EVs and PHEVs not utilizing the service or parking for longer than is designated by signage are subject to citation as provided in San Bernardino County Code Section 53.0606 and removal as provided in San Bernardino County Code Section 53.0607.

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(3) Electric vehicle charging station user fees shall be as provided in the ordinance setting forth the District's adopted recreation and park fees.

SECTION 3. The Board of Directors declares that it would have adopted this ordinance and each section, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of it irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, clauses, phrases or portions of it be declared invalid or unconstitutional. If for any reason any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, then all other provisions of it shall remain valid and enforceable.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from the date of adoption.
