

Ordinance No. SD 26-02

An ordinance of the Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District to repeal Ordinance No. SD 25-01 and to establish various recreation and park activity fees for Fiscal Years 2026-27, 2027-28 and 2028-29.

The Board of Directors of the Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District, San Bernardino County, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 2026, Ordinance No. SD 25-01 is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. The Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District recreation and park activity fees and charges shall hereby be established as follows:

18 of Public Works may defer payment of, waive, or refund any fee set forth			
19 in this chapter provided all of the following conditions are met:			
20 a) Exigent conditions exist whereby obtaining Board approval of the fee			
21 waiver/refund/deferral would not be immediately feasible; and			
22 b) The Director of Department of Public Works receives concurrence from			
23 the County Chief Executive Officer.
