**Briefly describe the general nature of the contract:**

In accordance with Master Agreement No. 08-5954F15 approval of Program Supplement Agreement No. F154 is required prior to County invoicing Caltrans for reimbursement of costs associated with the Preliminary Engineering (PE) phase of the replacement of Nicola Ditch bridge on National Trails Highway, 20.6 miles east of Kelbaker Road. The estimated PE phase cost is \$450,000 and will be funded with \$360,000 in federal Highway Bridge Program funds and \$90,000 in Discretionary General Funding.

The program supplement sets out special covenants as a condition for the local agency to receive federal-aid through the State for a designated project. The program supplement also identifies the type of funds available for reimbursement.
