IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

AMENDMENT NO.1

This Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment") is made by and between Hospital Association of Southern California ("Contractor"), and Inland Counties Emergency Medical Services Agency ("ICEMA") and modifies the not-to-exceed amount and terms of agreement No. 22-644 executed between the parties as of June 28th, 2022 ("Contract") and extends the contract period by an additional five years, retroactively from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2030.

1. Effective July 1, 2025, AMMEND **Section 1. TERM OF CONTRACT**, in entirety, to read:

1. TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of this CONTRACT shall be effective on July 1, 2022 and expire on June 30, 2030, for a period of eight (8) years, at a total cost not to exceed \$319,411, but may be terminated earlier in accordance with Section 7 – TERMINATION of the CONTRACT."

2. Effective July 1, 2025, AMMEND **Section 2.1 FISCAL PROVISIONS**, in entirety, to read:

2.1 The maximum amount of payment under this CONTRACT shall not exceed \$319,411.

3. Effective July 1, 2025, ADD fee schedules incorporated and attached hereto for the extended five – year period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2030, to the existing fee schedule labeled as “**APPENDIX A – PAYMENT TERMS**” in the Contract, as fully set forth therein..
4. Effective July 1, 2025, ADD the following as a new **Section 13, LEVINE ACT CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE**, and **Appendix E**, incorporated and attached herein, which shall read as follows:

13. LEVINE ACT CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE

Contractor has disclosed to the County using “Appendix E” – LEVINE ACT CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS DISCLOSURE, whether it has made any campaign contributions of more than \$500 to any member of the Board of Directors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector and the District Attorney] within the earlier of: (1) the date of the submission of Contractor’s proposal to the Board, or (2) 12 months before the date this Contract was approved by the Board of Directors. Contractor acknowledges that under Government Code section 84308, Contractor is prohibited from making campaign contributions of more than \$500 to any member of the Board of Directors or other County elected officer for 12 months after the Boards consideration of the Contract.

In the event of a proposed amendment to this Contract, the Contractor will provide ICEMA a written statement disclosing any campaign contribution(s) of more than \$500 to any member of the Board of Directors or other County elected officer within the preceding 12 months of the date of the proposed amendment.

Campaign contributions include those made by any agent/person/entity on behalf of the Contractor or by a parent, subsidiary, or otherwise related business entity of Contractor.

5. All other provisions and terms of the Contract shall remain the same and are hereby incorporated by reference. In the event of any conflict between the Contract and this Amendment, the terms and conditions of this Amendment shall control.
6. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same Amendment. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Amendment (whether by facsimile, PDF or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Amendment upon request.

APPENDIX E
Levine Act –
Campaign Contribution Disclosure
(formerly referred to as Senate Bill 1439)

The following is a list of items that are not covered by the Levine Act. A Campaign Contribution Disclosure Form will not be required for the following:

- Contracts that are competitively bid and awarded as required by law or County policy
- Contracts with labor unions regarding employee salaries and benefits
- Personal employment contracts
- Contracts under \$50,000
- Contracts where no party receives financial compensation
- Contracts between two or more public agencies
- The review or renewal of development agreements unless there is a material modification or amendment to the agreement
- The review or renewal of competitively bid contracts unless there is a material modification or amendment to the agreement that is worth more than 10% of the value of the contract or \$50,000, whichever is less
- Any modification or amendment to a matter listed above, except for competitively bid contracts.

DEFINITIONS

Actively supporting or opposing the matter: (a) Communicate directly with a member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, District Attorney, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector] for the purpose of influencing the decision on the matter; or (b) testifies or makes an oral statement before the County in a proceeding on the matter for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (c) communicates with County employees, for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (d) when the person/company's agent lobbies in person, testifies in person or otherwise communicates with the Board or County employees for purposes of influencing the County's decision in a matter.

Agent: A third-party individual or firm who, for compensation, is representing a party or a participant in the matter submitted to the Board of Supervisors. If an agent is an employee or member of a third-party law, architectural, engineering or consulting firm, or a similar entity, both the entity and the individual are considered agents.

Otherwise related entity: An otherwise related entity is any for-profit organization/company which does not have a parent-subsidary relationship but meets one of the following criteria:

- (1) One business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other business entity;
- (2) there is shared management and control between the entities; or
- (3) a controlling owner (50% or greater interest as a shareholder or as a general partner) in one entity also is a controlling owner in the other entity.

For purposes of (2), "shared management and control" can be found when the same person or substantially the same persons own and manage the two entities; there are common or commingled funds or assets; the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share activities, resources or personnel on a regular basis; or there is otherwise a regular and close working relationship between the entities.

Parent-Subsidiary Relationship: A parent-subsidiary relationship exists when one corporation has more than 50 percent of the voting power of another corporation.
