POLICY

- I. For water treatment systems with water softener, portable or stationary, hardness testing should be done.
- II. Hardness testing is performed by trained staff.
- III. Hardness testing is done to ensure that
 - A. The water softener is functioning properly.
 - B. The water hardness levels remain ≤ 0.6 grain per gallon or ≤ 10 parts per million (ppm).

IV. Procedures

- A. Hardness testing of water is done each treatment day
 - 1. Prior to the first patient shift and after the Reverse Osmosis (RO) system has been using incoming water for no less than 15 minutes of operation.
 - 2. At the end of the day after the last patient shift.
- B. Hardness testing is done using low-range water hardness reagent strips. Follow manufacturer's guideline when using the test strips.
- C. The sample is obtained immediately post softener or at the location as designated by the Arrowhead Regional Medical Center (ARMC) biomedical engineering services.
- D. Testing is documented on a designated log each time it is done.
- E. Completed logs are filed and maintained in the program's Water / Technical Master File.
