Extra Help Appointment of Public Information Officer as a Returning Retiree

California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act

Under the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act of 2013, a retired person shall not be eligible to be employed for a period of 180 days following the date of retirement unless the employer certifies the nature of the employment, and that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before 180 days have passed.



Returning Retiree

San Bernardino County Fire Protection District is requesting approval to appoint Tracey Martinez, a retiree, into an Extra Help Public Information Officer position.

This request requires Board approval due to:

- Ms. Martinez returning before 180 days have passed since she retired.
- The critical need of public communications during emergency incidents throughout the peak wildfire season, including urgent evacuations and community safety efforts.



Returning Retiree Conditions

- The appointment will be for the period of August 22, 2023 through June 30, 2024, at a compensation rate not to exceed \$53,779.
- The Extra Help position may be terminated by either party without cause upon 14 days' written notice to the other party.
- The appointee shall not be scheduled to work, and shall not work, more than 960 hours for the fiscal year.
