The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and the Third-Party Administrator (TPA) have completed the review of the Providing Access and Transforming Health (PATH) Justice Involved (JI) Round 4 applications. All applications were reviewed against the following criteria:

- Eligibility as a Round 3 awardee qualified to apply for Round 4 funding
- Submission of required programmatic narrative and budget describing need, justification, and alignment with permissible use categories
- Evaluation of permissible uses of funding, including planning, implementation, IT investments, technology upgrades, staffing, screening, collaboration, and operational readiness for Medi-Cal JI Reentry Services (90-day prerelease services).
- Minimum eligibility, narrative scoring, and budget scoring criteria.

We are pleased to inform you that DHCS awards you the final amount of **\$300,000.00 USD** for PATH JI Round 4. Awardees will receive 100% of their award upon completion of their Terms and Conditions.

JI Terms and Conditions

The JI Terms and Conditions document formalizes the contract between both parties and explains the responsibilities and expectations upon acceptance of the JI grant. The Terms and Conditions document is

viewable on the GrantsConnect portal where the application was completed. Please review, complete, sign and electronically submit the JI Terms and Conditions document in the GrantsConnect portal within thirty (30) days of receipt.

Progress Reporting Information

JI Round 4 awardees will be expected to complete a Final Progress Report. To ease administrative burden, this progress report will be combined with the Round 3 Final Progress Report, due June 30, 2026.

Agencies will be expected to provide an updated budget that is equal to the amount of funding awarded, indicated in this award letter. Awardees will be expected to report on how they will spend awarded Round 4 funds in alignment with JI Round 4 permissible uses. This budget will be reviewed by the TPA and DHCS and final approval will be provided DHCS. For awardees that are approved by DHCS to expend Round 4 funding beyond December 31, 2026, there will be additional reporting requirements.
