

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-172

**SENATE BILL 1 ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT
PROJECT LIST FOR 2025-26**

On Tuesday, August 5, on motion of Supervisor Baca, Jr., duly seconded by Supervisor Hagman and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure that the residents of San Bernardino County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in the County and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County has identified RMRA eligible projects and wishes to establish the 2025-26 RMRA project list as shown in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the County, will receive an estimated \$45,570,248 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-26 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the eighth year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on high priority and cost-effective projects that also meet community priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are in "good" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "excellent" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety will have significant positive benefits throughout the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California, as follow:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The list of newly proposed projects as shown in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, will be funded solely or in part with fiscal year 2025-26 RMRA revenues.

3. The list of adopted projects, as shown in Exhibit "A" Relisted Projects may also utilize Fiscal Year 2025-26 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the County is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
