Dear Claudia Walker:

San Bernardino County was awarded \$382,064 as the result of an application for the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction Program. Enclosed are two original Grant Award Agreements for signature. Please have the official designated in the Resolution from the Board of Supervisors sign and date both originals and return to the address below by October 4, 2019. Once the Agreements are fully executed, a signed Grant Award Agreement will be returned to you.

As noted in you award letter dated August 30, 2018, the California Department of Insurance (CDI) will seek permission from the Department of Finance to proceed with a disbursement of an additional \$500,000 during each year of the 3-year grant cycle. If we receive the authority to spend the full amount, your county will receive an amendment to this Grant Award Agreement.

A Resolution from the Board of Supervisors authorizing the applicant to enter into a Grant Award Agreement with CDI is required. The Resolution must designate, by title, the official authorized to sign the Grant Award Agreement and include a statement accepting liability for the local program. The Resolution must be received by December 31, 2019. Grant funds will not be distributed to the award recipient until the Resolution is received and the Grant Award Agreements are fully executed. Sample Resolution wording can be provided upon request.

Fiscal Year 2019-20

Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction Program ("Urban Grant")

The Insurance Commissioner of the State of California hereby makes an award of funds to **San Bernardino County**, Office of the District Attorney, in the amount and for the purpose and duration set forth in this grant award.

This grant award consists of this agreement and the application for the grant and made a part hereof. This also incorporates, by reference, the grantee's original application for funding as supplemented and/or modified by the conditions to this agreement. By acceptance of the grant award, the grant award recipient agrees to administer the grant project in accordance with all applicable statutes, regulations and the Request-for-Application (RFA).

Duration of Grant: The grant award is for the program period, July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

Purpose of Grant: This grant award is made pursuant to the provisions of California Insurance Code Section 1874.8; the emergency regulations adopted pursuant to California Insurance Code Section 1874.81, and shall be used solely for the purposes of prosecuting and eliminating organized automobile insurance fraud activity.

Amount of Grant: The grant award agreed to herein is in the amount of \$382,064. This amount has been determined by the Insurance Commissioner. However, the actual total award amount for the county is contingent on the collection and the authorization for expenditure pursuant to Government Code Section 13000 et seq. The grant award shall be distributed pursuant to Section 1874.8 of the Insurance Code and by the California Code of Regulations Subchapter 9, Article 5, Section 2698.73.
