SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4434

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regularly scheduled meeting on June 14, 2022, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance relating to reducing short-lived climate pollutants, organic waste disposal reduction and food recovery to comply with Senate Bill 1383 requirements.

Ordinance Summary

The ordinance amends Title 4, Division 6 of the San Bernardino County Code relating to reducing short-lived climate pollutants; adds Title 3, Division 3, Chapter 15 to the San Bernardino County Code relating to organic waste disposal reduction and food recovery; and adds section 14.0117 to the San Bernardino County Code relating to mulch procurement to comply with Senate Bill 1383. Senate Bill 1383 requires the County to have an ordinance in place to reduce the amount of solid waste sent to landfills and promote recycling in California, including organic waste recycling.
