RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY TO
PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OVER SEVEN TONS
ON OPAL AVENUE IN THE REDLANDS AREA

On Tuesday, August 18, 2026, on motion of Supervisor _____, duly seconded by Supervisor _____ and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works completed a traffic engineering investigation regarding trucks and other heavy vehicles along Opal Avenue in the Redlands area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, upon the basis of an engineering investigation, is authorized to prohibit the use of any street, road, or highway in an unincorporated residential subdivision area to commercial vehicles exceeding a gross weight pursuant to County Code Section 52.0125(c); and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors determines, upon the basis of a traffic engineering investigation, that it is necessary to prohibit use of commercial vehicles over seven tons on Opal Avenue (614350) between Colton Avenue and Citrus Avenue in the Redlands area to protect sensitive areas and against damage to County highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County as follows:

Due to conditions affecting the welfare of the public utilizing Opal Avenue in the Redlands area, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to a traffic engineering investigation, hereby finds and determines that traffic conditions require prohibiting the use of these roads to commercial vehicles over seven tons. Signs shall be installed, at minimum, on Opal Avenue, pursuant to County Code Section 52.0125(c), and the County Road Commissioner is directed to perform such acts as are necessary to accomplish the following:

- a. Pursuant to Section 52.0125(c)(1) of the County Code, Prohibit commercial vehicles exceeding a gross weight of 14,000 pounds (seven tons) from traveling on both sides of Opal Avenue (614350) between Colton Avenue (248100) and Citrus Avenue (240450) in the Redlands area.
