3 edge of this cove is located at: Longitude: North 34 degrees, 21 minutes, 23 seconds
4 Latitude: West 114 degrees, 11 minutes, 54 seconds.

5 (2) "No wake" and "speed zone" buoys shall be clearly marked and
6 placed in a manner which will make one or more of them plainly visible to boaters
7 approaching Black Meadow Landing Marina anywhere along the entire waterway opening
8 leading into this cove.

9 (c) *Havasu Palms Marina.*

10 (1) No person shall operate a boat or other vessel at greater than "no
11 wake" speed or above five miles per hour in areas designated "no wake zones" in the
12 cove area of the Colorado River commonly referred to as Havasu Palms Marina, which is
13 part of Lake Havasu and is within the area described as follows: The northernmost edge
14 of this cove is located at: Latitude: North 34 degrees, 24 minutes, 3.72 seconds Longitude:
15 West 114 degrees, 17 minutes, 5.58 seconds. The southernmost edge of this cove is
16 located at: Latitude: North 34 degrees, 24 minutes, 4.20 seconds Longitude: West 114
17 degrees, 16 minutes, 46.50 seconds.

18 (2) "No wake" and "speed zone" buoys shall be clearly marked and
19 placed in a manner which will make one or more of them plainly visible to boaters
20 approaching Havasu Palms Marina anywhere along the entire waterway opening leading
21 into this cove.

22 (d) *Unnamed Cove Located Seven/Tenths of a Mile North of Havasu Palms*
23 *Marina and Three/Tenths of a Mile Southwest of Pilot Rock.*

24 (1) No person shall operate a boat or other vessel at greater than "no
25 wake" speed or above five miles per hour in areas designated "no wake zones" in the
26 unnamed cove area of the Colorado River that is located seven-tenths of a mile north of
27 Havasu Palms and three-tenths of a mile southwest of Pilot Rock, which is part of Lake
28 Havasu, and is within the area described as follows: The northernmost edge of this cove

1 is located at: Longitude: North 34 degrees, 24 minutes, 51 seconds. Latitude: West 114
2 degrees, 17 minutes, 57 seconds. The southernmost edge of this cove is located at:
3 Longitude: North 34 degrees, 24 minutes, 22 seconds Latitude: West 114 degrees, 17
4 minutes, 37 seconds.

5 (2) "No wake" and "speed zone" buoys shall be clearly marked and
6 placed in a manner which will make one or more of them plainly visible to boaters
7 approaching the unnamed cove located seven-tenths of a mile north of Havasu Palms
8 Marina and three-tenths of a mile southwest of Pilot Rock anywhere along the entire
9 waterway opening leading into this cove.

10 (e) *Other Designated "No Wake Zones" and "Speed Zones" on Lake Havasu.*

11 (1) In addition to the restrictions set forth in Subdivisions (a) through (d)
12 above, on that portion of the Colorado River within the County's jurisdiction and commonly
13 referred to as Lake Havasu, it shall be unlawful to operate a boat or other vessel in
14 violation of marked "no wake zones" and "speed zones." Such zones may be designated
15 by the Sheriff to promote public safety and to reduce the hazards presented by conflicting
16 uses on the Colorado River by the boating public.

17 (2) All designated "no wake zones" and "speed zones" on Lake Havasu
18 shall be clearly marked by buoys placed in a manner which will make one or more of them
19 plainly visible to boaters approaching a designated "no wake zone."
