#### IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

#### **AMENDMENT NO. 2**

San Bernardino County ("County") and Darlene J. Martens ("Contractor") agree that Contract No. 22-352 ("the Contract") for Contractor to provide services as a Sheriff's Registered Dietitian to the County's Sheriff/Coroner/Public Administrator, is hereby amended effective September 27, 2025, as follows:

1) To replace Section III. TERM, AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION in its entirety, with a new Section III. TERM, AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION, which shall read as follows:

#### III. TERM, AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION

This Contract shall be effective September 29, 2021, and shall remain in effect through September 28, 2026, subject to the termination provisions below. The Sheriff/Coroner/Public Administrator, Undersheriff, or Assistant Sheriff are authorized to execute amendments to the Contract to extend the term for a

maximum of one successive one-year period upon satisfactory performance of the Contractor. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may terminate this Contract at any time without cause with a fourteen (14) day prior written notice to the other party. This Contract may be terminated for just cause immediately by the Sheriff/Coroner/Public Administrator. Contractor shall serve at the pleasure of the Sheriff/Coroner/Public Administrator, or his/her designee, who shall have the full authority and discretion to exercise County rights under this paragraph.

This Amendment No. 2, and if applicable, any subsequent amendments, may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same Amendment No. 2. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Amendment No. 2 (whether by facsimile, PDF or other mail transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Amendment No. 2 upon request.

Except as amended, all other terms and conditions of this Contract remain as the same.
