**SUBJECT**

Cooperative Agreement with the City of Montclair for Pavement Rehabilitation and Americans with Disabilities Act Curb Ramps Update on Various Roads in the Montclair and Chino Area

**RECOMMENDATION(S)**

1. Approve **Cooperative Agreement No. 20-1175** between the County of San Bernardino and the City of Montclair, wherein each agency will contribute \$5,570,000 and \$235,000 respectively, towards the \$5,805,000 estimated cost of the pavement rehabilitation and Americans with Disabilities Act curb ramps update on various roads in the Montclair and Chino area (Project).
2. Authorize the Director of Public Works to increase the County contribution amount up to 25 percent (from \$5,570,000 to \$6,962,500), should Project construction costs dictate such an increase.

**Ensure Development of a Well-Planned, Balanced, and Sustainable County.  
Pursue County Goals and Objectives by Working with Other Agencies.**

**FINANCIAL IMPACT**

Approval of this item will not result in the use of Discretionary General Funding (Net County Cost). The total estimated cost of the Project is \$5,805,000. The County of San Bernardino (County) share of cost is estimated to be \$5,570,000, plus an additional \$100,000 for right-of-way acquisition as a separate cost, with both to be funded with Senate Bill 1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds. The Project is included in the RMRA project list for 2020-21, as approved by the Board of Supervisors (Board) on April 21, 2020 (Item No. 45). The remaining cost of the Project, estimated to be \$235,000, will be funded by the City of Montclair (City). Sufficient appropriation and revenue for the Project are included in the Department of Public Works (Department) 2020-21 Road Operations budget and will be included in future recommended budgets (6650002000 20H15061/34H15066).

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Department has identified approximately 16 miles of roadway to improve and install new or upgrade existing pedestrian ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements at 56 locations throughout the Project area. Roadway rehabilitation consists of a slurry seal and/or scrub seal surface treatment or milling the existing pavement and overlaying the roadway with new asphalt concrete. The Project includes three roads of approximately 0.32 miles in

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which the County and City share jurisdiction and seven ADA curb ramps in the City's jurisdiction.

In accordance with the terms of the Cooperative Agreement, the County is the lead agency in the design, survey, California Environmental Quality Act review, construction, construction engineering, and inspection of the Project. Right-of-way activities inside the County's jurisdiction are anticipated and the County has agreed to acquire the right-of-way separately at its own cost. If right-of-way activities are needed within the City's jurisdiction, the City agrees to acquire the right-of-way separately at its own cost. The Project is early in the design phase and the actual right-of-way cost has not yet been determined. For this reason, the right-of-way costs are not included in the Cooperative Agreement. However, based on right-of-way costs for similar projects, it is anticipated that the cost for right-of-way acquisition will not exceed \$100,000. Unless terminated prior to the award of the construction contract, the Cooperative Agreement terminates upon completion of the Project and payment by the City, or December 31, 2025, whichever occurs first. The City approved the Cooperative Agreement on November 2, 2020.

The Project meets the County and Chief Executive Officer's goals and objectives to ensure the development of a well-planned, balanced and sustainable County by preserving and improving the structural integrity of existing road surfaces in conjunction with improving access for all pedestrians. Further, execution of the cooperative agreement and approval of the Project allow the County to meet its goals and objectives by working cooperatively with the City.

**PROCUREMENT**

Construction is anticipated to begin in the Spring of 2023 and be completed by the Summer of 2023.


