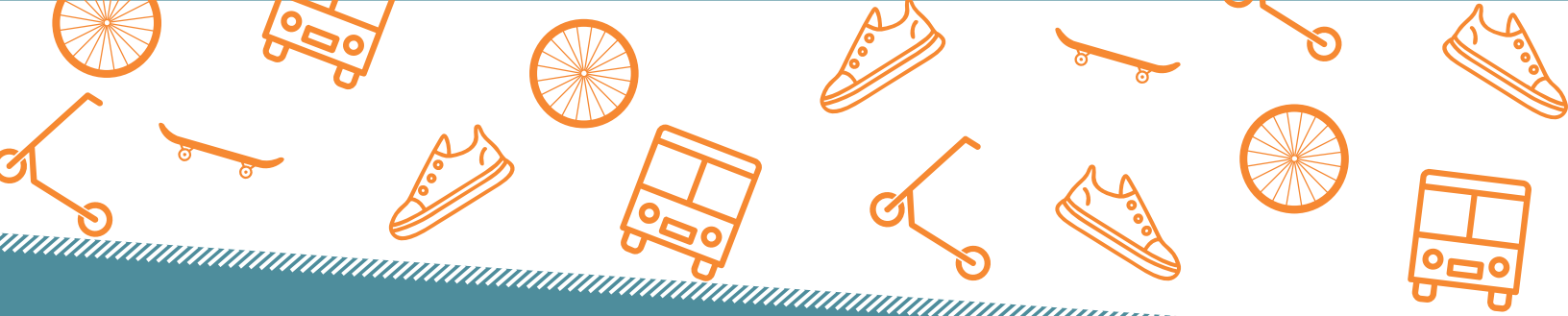

1. Please conduct these counts on AT LEAST two of the following three days Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday.
2. Please do not conduct these counts on Monday or Friday.
3. Before asking students to raise their hands, please read through all possible answer choices so they will know the available choices. Each student may only answer once.
4. Ask your students as a group the question, "How did you arrive at school today?"
5. Then, reread each answer choice and record the number of students that raised their hands for each choice.
6. Follow the same procedure for the question, "How do you plan to leave for home after school?"
7. Please conduct the survey once per day. During the count please ask students both school arrival and departure questions.
8. Please conduct the survey regardless of weather conditions.

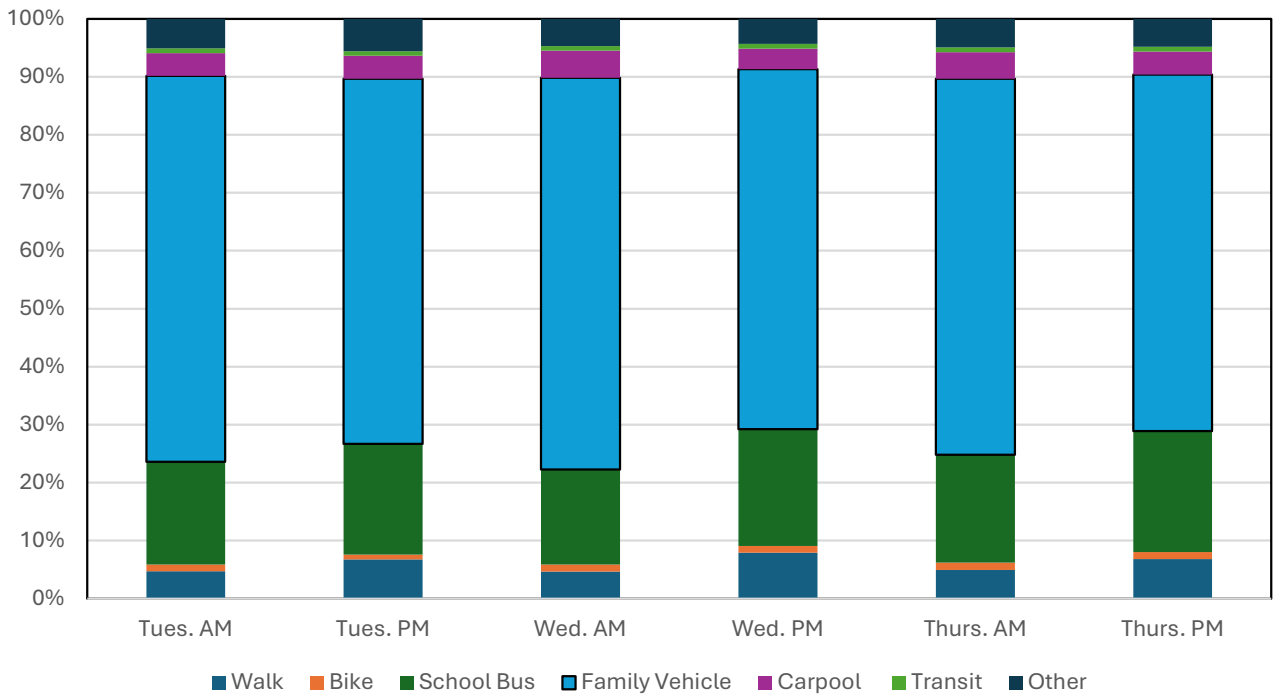

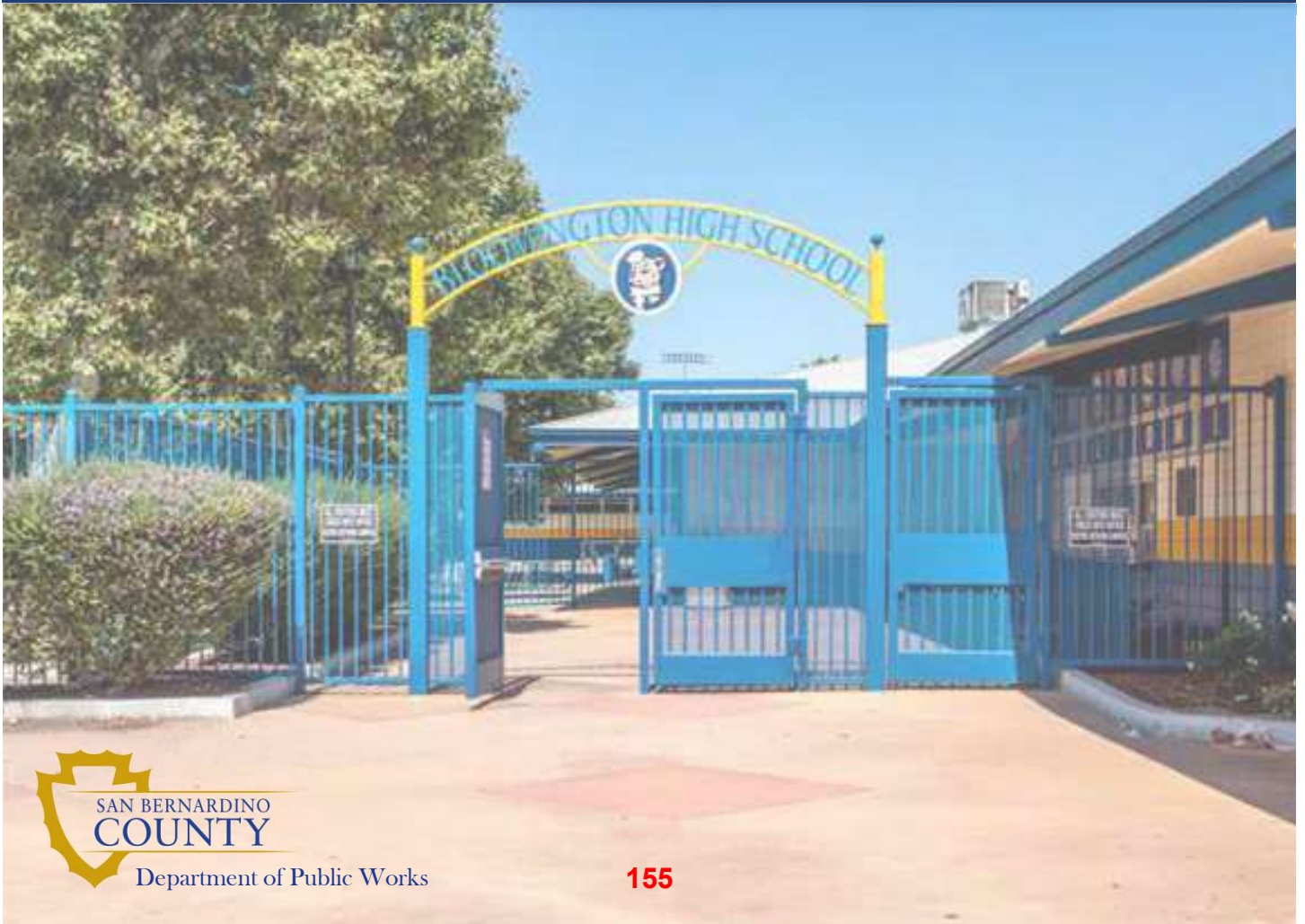

Project activities include the installment or construction of three

speed feedback signs, one “No Left Turn” and one “No Trucks” traffic control sign, four high visibility crosswalks and one high visibility mid-block crosswalk, two rectangular rapid flashing beacons, ten ADA-compliant curb ramps, 10,900 feet of sidewalk, and one traffic signal to replace an existing four-way stop. These adjustments will enhance the safety of students utilizing transportation infrastructure in the area surrounding Bloomington High School.
