- Camping or Occupancy of Temporary Structure Prohibition clarifies exemption for recreational camping and adds definition of Recreational Cabin.
- Minimum Residential Construction Standards updates requirements for manufactured homes to reference HCD certification.
- Landscape Grading Plan corrects threshold to 100 cubic yards.
- On-Site Signs corrects typos.
- Lien Agreements readopts Lien Agreements as an acceptable form of security for subdivision improvements.

Proposed Development Code Changes (continued)

- Location on Same or Contiguous Abutting Parcel clarifies development standards for contiguous parcels.
- Floodplain Safety Review Areas updates wording to conform to FEMA requirements.
- Residential Land Use Zoning District Development Standards Mountain Region removes obsolete footnote.
- Community Gardens add Community Gardens as an allowed use in certain zones.
- Short-Term Residential Rentals adds Short-Term Residential Rentals as a use allowed with a Special Use Permit in Resource Conservation (RC) and Agriculture (AG) Zones; authorizes legal nonconforming residential structures to be eligible for Short-Term Rental permits.

Planning Commission Hearing

Planning Commission Public Hearing on June 18, 2020

- PC made two changes to Staff's original recommendation:
 - ➤ Retain Lien Agreements in the Subdivision Chapter
 - ➤ Modified time period for use of an existing Recreational Cabin

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Conduct a public hearing to consider the proposed ordinance.
- 2. Make alterations, if necessary, to the proposed ordinance.
- 3. Approve introduction of the proposed ordinance.
- 4. Adopt the findings as recommended by the Planning Commission.
- 5. Read title only of the proposed ordinance; waive reading of the entire text and adopt the ordinance.
- 6. Direct the Clerk of the Board to file a Notice of Exemption.
