#### **COUNTY AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER GOALS & OBJECTIVES**

Provide for the Safety, Health and Social Service Needs of County Residents.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this item will not result in the use of Discretionary General Funding (Net County Cost). The total cost of \$248,829 is funded by State Medi-Cal, Federal Medicare, private insurance, and other departmental revenue. Funding sources may change in the future pending any legislative activity related to the repeal and/or replacement of the Affordable Care Act. Adequate appropriation and revenue have been included in the Arrowhead Regional Medical Center (ARMC) 2024-25 budget and will be included in future recommended budgets.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

ARMC uses Automatic Transfer Switches (ATS) to ensure the continuous delivery of electrical power across its facilities, essential for critical operations such as lighting, computer systems, and medical equipment. ATS assemblies provide an automatic transfer between primary and alternate sources of power when there is a failure or disruption in the primary source. The Contract with ASCO Power Technologies (ASCO) will allow ARMC to receive maintenance and repairs of its ATS to ensure that ARMC can continue to operate without power interruptions, thereby safeguarding the safety, health, and well-being of county residents who rely on ARMC's services..

ARMC recommends approval of the Contract to ensure the ATS are serviced and repaired to provide continuous delivery of electrical power throughout ARMC for the safety, health and social service needs of county residents.

# Contract with ASCO Power Technologies for Maintenance and Repairs of Automatic Transfer Switches October 22, 2024

The Purchasing Department supports this non-competitive procurement based on specialized credentials/expertise/training. ASCO is the manufacturer of the ATS equipment and has specialized credentials, expertise, training and is the only authorized service provider to service and repair the equipment.
