**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY
TO ACCEPT INTO THE COUNTY MAINTAINED ROAD SYSTEM MOUNTAIN VIEW
BOULEVARD FROM DIVISION DRIVE EAST IN THE BIG BEAR CITY AREA,**

On Tuesday, November 4, 2025, on motion of Supervisor Baca, Jr., duly seconded by Supervisor Hagman and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

WHEREAS, Section 941 of the Streets and Highways Code provides that no public or private road shall become a County highway until and unless accepted by appropriate action of the Board of Supervisors, or the Board's designee; and

WHEREAS, Mountain View Boulevard from Division Drive east for approximately 0.24 miles in the Big Bear City Area shall be constructed and approved to County standards; and

WHEREAS, right-of-way for Mountain View Boulevard from Division Drive east for approximately 0.24 miles in the Big Bear City Area has been dedicated to San Bernardino County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County that Mountain View Boulevard, from Division Drive east for approximately 0.24 miles, in the Big Bear City Area, is necessary to the public convenience and, therefore, are accepted into the County Maintained Road System.
