* Why is this project a good fit for this site? How will youth benefit from their participation in BOOF?

Chaparral HS is a small, non-traditional school in a very rural part of the High Desert. Students typically have low self-worth because of negative school and life experiences and tend to thrive when given a leadership opportunity or chance to make a difference. Because of the remote nature of the school district, students turn to gambling as a form of entertainment and escape, often learning these behaviors from their family members.

* Has this site had any experience meeting virtually? What is this site's capacity to collaborate, while physically distancing, to implement this project?

Yes, they meet virtually for class every day. This chapter was also able to pivot after the shutdown in March and finish their BOOF campaign remotely. There are several students returning this year who have learned important lessons that will be used to make virtual meetings more effective.
