ADDENDUM NO. 2

**TO THE PLANS AND BID DOCUMENTS FOR THE PHASE 1B LINER
CONSTRUCTION PROJECT
at the LANDERS SANITARY LANDFILL
in Landers, California**

BID OPEN: 10:00 A.M. February 3, 2026

The following changes and/or additions shall be made to the Plans and Bid Documents for the Phase 1B Liner Construction Project at the Landers Sanitary Landfill. All other requirements of the Plans and Bid Documents shall remain the same.

The following changes shall be made part of the Contract Documents, and the Bidder should acknowledge receipt thereof on the Bid Proposal.

I. PROJECT SPECIFICATION REVISION

1. Delete and replace Bid Proposal Checklist and Assembly Pages 3 and 4 with the revised Bid Proposal Checklist and Assembly Pages 3-A and 4-A included with Addendum No. 2 as Attachment 1.

Attention is directed to the BLUE PAGES Standard Contract, Article V – Bonds, Indemnity and Insurance, Subsection 5.1 – Bonds, and BLUE PAGES General Conditions, Section 11 Insurance and Bonds, Subsection 11.1 - Performance Bond and Payment Bond, Paragraph 11.1.1 - Bond Requirements, of the Bid Documents. The following provision is emphasized as part of this Addendum No. 2:

“The Bonds must comply with all requirements in the Contract Documents, be on County approved bond forms, and be secured from a surety company

satisfactory to the County within ten (10) calendar days of the award of the Contract.”

II. PROJECT QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. What is the Engineers estimate for the Project?

A1. *The County does not share the Engineer’s estimate.*

2. Can the Contractor use the existing power onsite for our operations?

A2. *The County may authorize the use of existing power onsite for Contractor’s operations, provided that the Contractor can demonstrate there is adequate power to sustain both current and estimated increase loads. If authorized, Contractor shall install and pay for a temporary meter to service its operations. Any analysis, upgrades, temporary facilities, equipment, or modifications required to accommodate such use shall be at no additional cost to the County and be restored back to its original condition upon completion of construction. Power lines/poles located by the landfill gas treatment facility are shown in Addendum No. 2 as Attachment 2. Please refer to Section 2B – Construction Support Tasks, Subsection 1.2 – Temporary Facilities for Own Use & Subsection 1.4 – Protection of Existing Utilities of the Technical Specifications.*

3. Will the County allow the processing of the existing rock onsite to produce aggregates needed for the project (i.e. CMB & LCRS Gravel)?

A3. *The County has no objections to the Contractor, at no additional cost to the County, to process existing onsite rock stockpile to produce aggregates needed for the Project. Any construction material produced from the existing rock stockpile for use on the Project (including, but not limited to, CMB and LCRS Gravel) must comply with all applicable testing requirements, specifications, and provisions of the Technical Specifications. The Project team, however, is not confident that the existing onsite rock stockpile material will meet all requirements for LCRS Gravel.*

The Contractor shall be solely responsible for determining whether to process the existing material onsite for use as aggregate or to transport the material directly to the Southeast Rock Stockpile.

The Contractor is advised that if it elects to process the existing material onsite, a reduction in compensation is anticipated, as payment under Billing Item No. 7 is based on the quantity of material delivered to the Southeast Rock Stockpile. Please refer to Section 2C – Earthwork, Subsection 4.3 – Rock Stockpile Excavation/Transport to Southeast Rock Stockpile, Item No. 7.

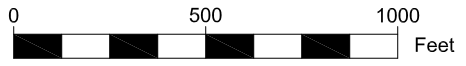
