

ORDINANCE NO. SD 22-_____

An ordinance of Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District to establish various recreation and park activity fees for Fiscal Year 2022-23 and to repeal Ordinance No. SD 20-04.

The Board of Directors of the Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District, County of San Bernardino, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 20202, Ordinance No. SD ~~1920-034~~ is repealed in its entirety.
