SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regularly scheduled meeting on _____, 2021, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance relating to the adjustment of boundaries of supervisorial districts.

Ordinance Summary

The ordinance amends Section 12.0102 of Chapter 1 of Division 2 of Title 1 of the San Bernardino County Code relating to Supervisorial Districts. The ordinance adjusts supervisorial district boundaries to ensure that supervisorial districts are reasonably equal in population and conform to the federal Voting Rights Act and state Fair And Inclusive Redistricting for Municipalities And Political Subdivisions (FAIR MAPS) Act. The adjustments are based on the 2020 updated population figures from the United States Census Bureau showing a total population of 2,181,654 and a population as adjusted by California under state law of 2,180,152.
