SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4503

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, January 13, 2026, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance relating to long term parking and regulation of large and commercial vehicles in unincorporated area of Spring Valley Lake.

Ordinance Summary

The ordinance adds Chapter 12 (Long-Term Parking in Spring Valley Lake) to Title 5, Division 3, to the San Bernardino County Code to regulate the long-term parking of large vehicles, recreational vehicles, trailers, and commercial vehicles on public streets within Spring Valley Lake. It establishes restrictions that prohibit parking such vehicles in the same location for more than 72 consecutive hours and requires they be moved at least 500 feet thereafter in order to enhance public safety, improve traffic flow, and protect the community's quality of life.
