IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

**AMENDMENT NO. 2**

It is hereby agreed to amend Contract No. 21-563 as follows:

**SECTION III. CONTRACTOR GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES**

**Add Paragraph QQ. to read as follows:**

QQ. **Campaign Contribution Disclosure (SB 1439)** – Contractor has disclosed to the County using Attachment F – Campaign Contribution Disclosure (AB 1439), whether it has made any campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors within the earlier of: (1) the date of the submission of Contractor’s proposal to the County, or (2) 12 months before the date this Contract was approved by the Board of Supervisors. Contractor acknowledges that under Government Code section 84308, Contractor is prohibited from making campaign contributions of more than \$250 to

any member of the Board of Supervisors for twelve (12) months after the County's consideration of the Contract.

In the event of a proposed amendment to this Contract, the Contractor will provide the County a written statement disclosing any campaign contribution(s) of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors within the preceding twelve (12) months of the date of the proposed amendment.

Campaign contributions include those made by any agent/person/entity on behalf of the Contractor or by a parent, subsidiary, or otherwise related business entity of contractor.

## **SECTION V. FISCAL PROVISIONS**

### **Amend Section V., Paragraph A. to read as follows:**

- A. The maximum amount of cost reimbursement under this Contract shall not exceed a cumulative total of \$310,000, of which \$310,000 may be Federally funded, and shall be subject to availability of funds to the County. The consideration to be paid to each Contractor, as provided herein, shall be in full payment for all Contractor's services and expenses incurred in the performance hereof, including travel and per diem. Overtime and holiday make-up time will not be permitted. Payments are subject to provisions in the Payments, Budgets, Closeout, and Audits.

## **SECTION VIII. TERM**

### **Amend Section VIII. to read as follows:**

This Contract is effective as of July 1, 2021 and expires June 30, 2025, but may be terminated earlier in accordance with provisions of Section IX of the Contract. The Contract term may be extended for one (1) additional one (1) year period by mutual agreement of the parties.

## ATTACHMENT F

### Campaign Contribution Disclosure (SB 1439)

#### **DEFINITIONS**

Actively supporting the matter: (a) Communicate directly with a member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, District Attorney, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector] for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (b) testifies or makes an oral statement before the County in a proceeding on the matter; or (c) communicates with County employees, for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (d) when the person/company's agent lobbies in person, testifies in person or otherwise communicates with the Board or County employees for purposes of influencing the County's decision in a matter.

Agent: A third-party individual or firm who, for compensation, is representing a party or a participant in the matter submitted to the Board of Supervisors. If an agent is an employee or member of a third-party law, architectural, engineering or consulting firm, or a similar entity, both the entity and the individual are considered agents.

Otherwise related entity: An otherwise related entity is any for-profit organization/company which does not have a parent-subsidary relationship but meets one of the following criteria:

- (1) One business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other business entity;
- (2) there is shared management and control between the entities; or
- (3) a controlling owner (50% or greater interest as a shareholder or as a general partner) in one entity also is a controlling owner in the other entity.

For purposes of (2), "shared management and control" can be found when the same person or substantially the same persons own and manage the two entities; there are common or commingled funds or assets; the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share activities, resources or personnel on a regular basis; or there is otherwise a regular and close working relationship between the entities.

Parent-Subsidiary Relationship: A parent-subsidiary relationship exists when one corporation has more than 50 percent of the voting power of another corporation.
