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An ordinance of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino calling a special election on the initiative petition/measure entitled “San Bernardino County Supervisor Compensation Reduction and Term Limits.”

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2019, pursuant to Elections Code section 9100 et seq., proponents submitted a Notice of Intent to circulate the petition for the purpose of amending the County Charter to outline the terms of office for the County Supervisor position including the duties, compensation and limitations that apply to the office; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Initiative Petition/Measure was filed with the County of San Bernardino Registrar of Voters; and

WHEREAS, on or about May 1, 2020, the County of San Bernardino Registrar of Voters certified the Initiative Petition/Measure; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2020, the County of San Bernardino Registrar of Voters presented to the Certification of Initiative Petition/Measure to the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code section 9118, the Board of Supervisors shall either adopt the Initiative Petition/Measure by ordinance, without alteration, or submit the ordinance, without alteration, to the voters pursuant to Elections Code section 1405; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2020, the Board of Supervisors directed staff to determine how this ordinance affects the appointments to boards of outside agencies and report back on June 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2020, the Board of Supervisors decided to submit the ordinance, without alteration, to the voters pursuant to Elections Code section 1405; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 23730 requires the governing body to call a special election by ordinance for a Charter amendment presented by petition

1 which shall specify the purpose and time of such election and shall establish the
2 election precincts and designate the polling places therein, and the names of the
3 election officers for each such precinct.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, The Board of Supervisors of the County San Bernardino,
5 State of California, ordains as follows:

7 SECTION 1. A special election shall be conducted on November 3, 2020, and
8 consolidated with the General Election, to submit to the voters a Measure to adopt an
9 ordinance entitled "San Bernardino County Supervisor Compensation Reduction and
10 Term Limits." Said ordinance is attached hereto as Exhibit "A." The aforesaid
11 proposed ordinance shall be submitted to the electors of the County of San Bernardino
12 at an election to be held and conducted on November 3, 2020, and the polls shall be
13 open from the hour of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on said Election Day. Said election shall
14 be and is hereby consolidated with the Presidential General Election to be held on said
15 day, and all precincts established, and all election officers appointed, for said
16 consolidated election shall be the precincts and election officers for said election, and
17 said election officers shall conduct said election and make return thereof according to
18 law.

19 SECTION 2. Measure "____" to be submitted to the voters shall be as follows:

SECTION 3. Measure “_____” shall go into effect only if approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting in an election to be held on November 3, 2020, and shall become effective ten (10) days after the Board of Supervisors has, by Resolution, declared that such Measure was approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.

SECTION 4. The San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors hereby order that the election on this Measure be consolidated with any and all elections in the same territory to be conducted on November 3, 2020 and that the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters conduct the election.

SECTION 5. The election will be held and conducted, election officers appointed, voting precincts designated, ballots printed, polls opened and closed, ballots counted and returned, returns canvasses, results declared, certificates of election issued and all of the proceedings incidental to and connected with the election shall be regulated and done in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the election with which this election is consolidated.

SECTION 6. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby instructed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters.
