

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-117

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2024-139, AUTHORIZING THE VICTIM SERVICES CHIEF TO ELECTRONICALLY EXECUTE AND SUBMIT TO THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES A GRANT APPLICATION NECESSARY TO FUND THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, TO CORRECT THE DATE OF THE GRANT AWARD PERIOD AND AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL SIGNATORY ROLES

On Tuesday June 10, 2025, on motion of Supervisor Baca, Jr., duly seconded by Supervisor Hagman and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2024 (Item No. 33), the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2024-139 authorizing the Victim Services Chief for San Bernardino County District's Attorney's Office to electronically execute and submit on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, San Bernardino County, the Grant Application for the Victim Witness Assistance Program to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES);

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors seeks to amend Resolution No. 2024-139 to correct the date of the grant award period and authorize additional signatory roles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County the following:

1. That the Victim Services Chief is authorized to electronically execute and submit, on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, San Bernardino County, the Grant Application for the Victim Witness Assistance Program for October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025 and all related documents, including any subsequent, non-substantive amendments, upon review by County Counsel.
2. That the District Attorney, Victim Services Chief and Chief District Attorney Administration are authorized to execute and submit, on behalf of San Bernardino County, grant budget modifications and claims for expense reimbursement related to the Victim Witness Assistance Program grant.

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the submission and performance in connection with the Grant Application, including civil court action for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and Cal OES disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
