**IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

**AMENDMENT No. 3**

Contract No. 23-35, in which San Bernardino County (County), by and through the Sheriff/Coroner/Public Administrator (Sheriff), provides contract law enforcement services to the Victor Valley Transit Authority (Authority), a public transit agency, for its Passenger Bus System (System) covering the San Bernardino High Desert cities and unincorporated county areas, is hereby amended, effective June 23, 2026, as follows:

(1) To delete Section D.1, in its entirety, and replace it with new Section D.1, as follows:

**D.1** This Contract is effective as of February 1, 2023 and expires June 30, 2027, but may be terminated earlier in accordance with provisions of this Contract. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Contract may be terminated at any time, with or without cause, by Authority or by County upon written notice given to the other at least one year prior to the date specified for such termination. Any such termination date shall coincide with the end of a calendar month. In the event of such termination, each party shall fully pay and discharge all obligations in favor of the other, accruing prior to the date of such termination, and each party shall be released from all obligations or performance which would otherwise accrue subsequent to the date of such termination. In the event of termination of this Agreement, the County shall refund any sum previously paid by Authority which, when prorated, represents advance payment for months of service that are not performed as a result of such termination. Neither party shall incur any liability to the other by reason of such termination.

(2) To delete Schedule A cited in section F.1, in its entirety, and replace it with a new Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, payable in monthly and quarterly installments.

(3) To add section C.51 as follows:

**C.51 Prohibition on Contracting with Entities that Require Certain Internal Confidentiality Agreements or Statements-Representation (FAR 52.203-18).**

In compliance with Federal Acquisition Regulation 52.203-18, Agency shall not require employees or subcontractors of Agency seeking to report waste, fraud, or abuse, to sign internal confidentiality agreements or statement prohibiting or otherwise restricting such employees or subcontractors from lawfully reporting such waste, fraud or abuse to a designated investigative or law enforcement representative of a Federal department or agency authorized to receive such information. To the extent Agency has required employees or subcontractors to sign internal confidentiality agreements or statements in the past, Agency shall notify current employees and subcontractors that those prohibitions and restrictions are no longer in effect. Agency shall include this clause in all subcontracts.

(4) To add section C.52 as follows:

**C.52 Use of Biobased Products (FAR 52.223-1)**

Agency certifies that to the extent biobased products are purchased using Contract funds, Agency shall comply with Federal Acquisition Regulation 52.223-1.

(5) To add section C.53 as follows:

**C.53 Service Contract Labor Standards (FAR 52.222-52, 52.222-53, 22.1003-4)**

To the extent applicable, Agency agrees to comply with and to provide any information necessary for the County to comply with Federal Acquisition Regulations 52.222-52, 52.222-53, and 22.1003-4.

Except as amended, all other terms and conditions of this Contract remain as stated therein.
