**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4474**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, July 23, 2024, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance relating to increasing the Uniform Transient Occupancy Tax, making minor administrative revisions to the language, and ordering that the proposal be submitted to the qualified electors at the November 5, 2024 election.

Ordinance Summary

The ordinance is to place a measure on the November 5, 2024 ballot, to provide funding for San Bernardino County infrastructure and services by increasing the transient occupancy tax, paid by occupants of hotels and vacation rentals, from 7% to 11% providing approximately an additional \$9,400,000 annually for general government use and making minor administrative revisions to County Code section 14.0203.
