RESOLUTION NO. 2021-130

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO LEVYING SPECIAL TAXES WITHIN COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2003-1 (CITRUS PLAZA/MOUNTAIN GROVE)

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board of Supervisors") of the County of San Bernardino (the "County") has conducted proceedings under the Mello-Roos Community Facility Act of 1982 (commencing with Government Code section 53311 et seq.) (the "Act") to establish Community Facilities District No. 2003-1 (Citrus Plaza/Mountain Grove), County of San Bernardino, State of California (the "Community Facilities District"), to authorize the levy of special taxes (the "Special Taxes") upon the land within the Community Facilities District and to issue bonds secured by the Special Taxes, the proceeds of which are to be used to finance certain public facilities (the "Facilities").

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, as the legislative body of the Community Facilities District, is authorized under the Act to levy certain special taxes with the Community Facilities District to pay for certain public services (the "Special Taxes for Services") and to levy certain special taxes within the Community Facilities District to pay for the costs of certain public facilities.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Ordinance No. SD 08-15, adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County on August 12, 2008, authorized and levied the Special Taxes within the Community Facilities District, as applicable;

WHEREAS, Section 53340 of the Act provides that the legislative body of a community facilities district may provide, by resolution, for the levy of the special tax in the current year or future tax years at the same rate or at a lower rate than the rate provided by ordinance, if the resolution is adopted and a certified list of all parcels subject to the special tax levy including the amount of the tax to be levied on each parcel for the applicable tax year, is filed by the clerk or other official designated by the legislative body with the county auditor on or before the 10th day of August of that tax year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to levy the Special Taxes within the Community Facilities District, as applicable, for Fiscal Year 2021-22,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino as follows:

Section 1. All of the above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby levies the Special Taxes for the Fiscal Year 2021-22 at the rates and with respect to the parcels as set forth in Exhibit A hereto. The Director of the Department of Public Works - Special Districts of the County is hereby authorized and directed to file with the San Bernardino County Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector no

later than August 10, 2021, a certified list of all parcels subject to the Special Tax levy including the amount of the Special Taxes to be levied on each parcel for Fiscal Year 2021-22.

Section 3. The officers and agents of the County are, and each of them hereby is, authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all documents and instruments and to do and cause to be done any and all acts and things necessary or proper for carrying out the levy of the Special Taxes for Fiscal Year 2021-22 as provided in this Resolution.

Section 4. All actions heretofore taken by the officers and agents of the County with respect to the levy of the Special Taxes for Fiscal Year 2021-22 are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
