**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE OFFICIAL AUTHORIZATION AND EXECUTION OF A
COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CHINO FOR A REQUEST TO THE UNITED
STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR METROPOLITAN
CITY/URBAN COUNTY JOINT RECIPIENT STATUS**

On Tuesday, June 23, 2026, on motion of Supervisor _____, duly seconded by Supervisor _____ and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

WHEREAS, Federal regulations require that San Bernardino County (County) re-qualify every three (3) years for Urban County Status for the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, any Metropolitan City, located in whole or in part within the County, can request HUD to approve inclusion of the Metropolitan City as a part of the Urban County for purposes of planning and implementing HUD entitlement grants; and,

WHEREAS, HUD has determined that the City of Chino has sufficient population to qualify as a Metropolitan City and therefore receive an allocation of entitlement grant funds directly from HUD; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Chino (City) has requested to become a participant of San Bernardino County's Urban County and have its allocation of HUD entitlement grants be included in the County's allocation of HUD entitlement grants; and

WHEREAS, an approved joint request must remain effective for the period for which the County qualifies as an Urban County; and,

WHEREAS, HUD requires that Cooperation Agreements and any amendments thereto be officially authorized by the governing board of the County and of each participating city, and be executed by their respective chief executive officers; and,

WHEREAS, the County and the City intend to enter into a Cooperation Agreement governing such participation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County does hereby find, determine, and order as follows:

Section 1. San Bernardino County, an Urban County, hereby joins with the City of Chino, a Metropolitan City, in a request to HUD for inclusion of Chino, a Metropolitan City, as part of the Urban County for planning and implementing HUD's Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships Program and Emergency Solutions grants.

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the use of the Cooperation Agreement and any amendments thereto consistent with this Resolution and the HUD program requirements.

Section 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the County's Chief Executive Officer to execute, on behalf of the County, the Cooperation Agreement and any amendments thereto

consistent with this Resolution and the HUD program requirements, together with any certificates, attachments, and ancillary documents necessary to implement the Cooperation Agreement.

Section 4. The Joint Request will remain in effect starting July 1, 2027, through June 30, 2030, and shall renew automatically for one successive three-year Urban County qualification period, unless revoked by either party pursuant to the HUD required process.

Section 5. This Joint Request shall accompany and be a part of the submission by the County as part of the County's Urban County Qualification documentation to HUD.

Section 6. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.

Section 7. If any provision of this Resolution is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
