

**SECOND AMENDMENT**  
**CASEY FAMILY PROGRAMS**

**CHILD WELFARE COLLABORATION AGREEMENT**

Pursuant to Section 2.2 of their January 1, 2023 Child Welfare Collaboration Agreement, as amended (Agreement), Casey Family Programs (CFP) and San Bernadino County Children and Family Services (CFS) enter into this Second Amendment to the Agreement, effective January 1, 2025 (Second Amendment). The Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Term.** The Term of the Agreement is hereby extended for one additional year, and shall continue until December 31, 2026, unless sooner terminated or amended by agreement of the Parties.
- 2. 2025 Strategy and Identified Outcomes Plan.** In 2025, the Parties shall undertake the Strategies in the 2025 Strategy and Identified Outcomes Plan detailed in Attachment 3, which is hereby incorporated to the Agreement. Throughout the Term of the Agreement, the Collaboration Leads shall document the Work Efforts and Collaboration Strategies in the Work Plan. On a quarterly basis, the Parties shall evaluate and document the progress and impact of the Collaboration Strategies and Work Efforts according to the reporting schedule in Attachment 3.
- 3. Agreement otherwise in full force and effect.** Except as specifically set forth herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
