**Project Location:** This Project is located at the intersection of Cactus Avenue and Easton Street in the City of Rialto.

**Project Description:** This Project consists of four traffic signal installation and four ADA curb ramp replacement at the intersection of Cactus Avenue and Easton Street, in the City of Rialto.

The Project consists of maximum excavation depth per project component of 2 feet for ADA ramp replacements and 15 feet for mast poles foundations for utility poles, and mill and overlay, slurry seal, chip seal, Glaspave, leveling course, micro milling, and patching. Utility relocation is not required. The equipment used will include, tractor, asphalt paver, backhoe, dump truck, and crane. No traffic detours or nighttime construction are planned. Construction activities will occur on or adjacent to existing roads, asphalt or graded and maintained dirt shoulder. Construction duration is anticipated to be 30 working days.


