Compliance Program/Activity

■ Compliance Program/Activity:

- Continue Coordination of interpretation services for CyraCom.
- Monthly review/audit for patients who are deaf or hard of hearing. Review/audit to determine if patient was provided appropriate aid or interpreter in a timely manner.
- Audit Form 700 filing for CY 2022, staff and contractors.

- **Compliance Program Review:**
 - Monthly review of the Office of Inspector General (OIG) exclusion list to ensure vendors and staff are not excluded from Federally funded health care programs (Ongoing).
 - There were no incidents of Fraud, Waste or Abuse reported for this quarter.

Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) Privacy & Security Report Highlights

- Epic Hyperdrive implementation and rollout strategies have been completed. 3000 desktop computers and 2000 virtual desktop environments have been upgraded with the latest Epic client software. All third-party applications integrations (Imprivata, OnBase, 3M, Nuance) tested successfully. Epic Hyperdrive is now configured to run locally on virtual desktops, this eliminates the need of another Citrix session and improves Epic connection speed times.
- Epic Hyperdrive local install on desktop computers testing initiated. Some medical imaging desktop computers are now configured with this solution. Third-party application testing is completed for Imprivata, OnBase, 3M and Nuance. Wacom is in progress. Next step is to determine rollout strategies.

Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) Privacy & Security Report Highlights

- Bitwarden, an Enterprise Password Manager solution has been implemented and configured. Password information has been transferred, user accounts have been transferred and documentation is now completed. Next steps are to finalize rollout strategy and administer user training.
- Imprivata PAM (Privileged Access Management) servers' implementation and configuration is now completed. Next steps are; environment configuration, Active Directory integration, documentation, rollout strategies, and user training.

HIPAA Reportable Breaches

- June 7, 2023 – A registry employee inappropriately accessed and viewed the EMR of a jail patient. The breach was reported to California Department of Public Health and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services - Office for Civil Rights. The department completed correction action including staff training.
- June 12, 2023 - A registry clinic employee inappropriately accessed and viewed the EMR of a patient. The breach was reported to California Department of Public Health and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services - Office for Civil Rights. Appropriate corrective action completed.

Regulatory Update – Regulatory and Accrediting Agencies

- ARMC underwent sixteen (16) CDPH visits investigating a total of forty-one (41) complaint / follow-up cases resulting from patients, families, self-reports, and/or from employees or other anonymous sources that were investigated.
- ARMC received three (5) CDPH deficiency requiring a corrective action plan related to:
 - June - Quality of care complaint in 2021
 - July - Two self reported Hospital Acquired Pressure Injury (HAPI) / Quality of Care (ACLS documentation)
 - August – one self report HAPI / one self report staff to patient abuse
- Licensing Survey
 - 7/25 - Fontana Clinic's New Mammogram
 - 7/28 – DaVinci Surgical Equipment
