RESOLUTION NO. 2025-119

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE INLAND COUNTIES EMERGENCY MEDICAL AGENCY ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26

On Tuesday June 10, 2025, on motion of Director Hagman, duly seconded by Director Baca, Jr., and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Directors of Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 29080 of the Government Code, a notice was published on May 21, May 22, May 25, May 26 and May 27, 2025, in a newspaper of general circulation throughout the County regarding the availability of the 2025-26 Recommended Budget documents, on file with the Secretary of the Board. The notice also set forth that on June 10, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., a public hearing would be conducted on the 2025-26 Recommended Budget for the Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency. The documents were available to the public on May 20, 2025, at least 10 days prior to the public hearing. The notice further set forth that any member of the public may appear at the hearing and be heard regarding any item in the Recommended Budget or for the inclusion of additional items. Finally, the notice set forth the requirement that all proposals for revisions should be submitted in writing to the Secretary of the Board before the close of the public hearing.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 29080 through 29092 of the Government Code, the Governing Board of the Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency, on June 10, 2025 held a duly noticed hearing for the purpose of considering the Recommended Budget, including any financing requirements of the Recommended Budget, less deletions and reductions, plus such additions and increases as may be made by order of the Board during the budget hearing and prior to the adoption of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Board of the Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency hereby finds, determines, declares, and resolves as follows:

- Section 1. All of the above recitals are true and correct.
- Section 2. A duly noticed public hearing on the 2025-26 Recommended Budget was held. All requests regarding the Recommended Budget were received and considered by the Board.
- Section 3. At the conclusion of the hearing, and after making any revisions of, deductions from, or increases or additions to, the Recommended Budget (as presented in the Recommended Budget Book and Attachment A) that it deems advisable, pursuant to Government Code Sections 29089 and 29090, the Board hereby refers to the financing uses in the Recommended Budget and adopts the Budget as finally determined ("Adopted Budget"). The County's Chief Executive Officer is hereby authorized to make changes to the Adopted Budget only to accommodate actual fund balance as determined at year end and any technical balancing adjustments to appropriation, revenue, and available reserves as described in Attachment A which has been adopted by the Governing Board of the Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency. The Adopted Budget as finally determined meets the requirements set forth in Government Code Section 29089.
- Section 4. Pursuant to Government Code Section 29089 (f), the Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency hereby makes provisions for five fund balance classifications (required as a result of the adoptions and implementation of GASB 54). The provisions for use of these classifications of fund balance in 2025-26 are detailed below:

Nonspendable Fund Balance: Not available for appropriation in any of the funds.

Restricted Fund Balance - Governmental Funds: Available for appropriation.

<u>Committed</u>, <u>Assigned and Unassigned Fund Balance</u>: Available for appropriation in all governmental funds.

The funds in the 2025-26 Recommended Budget either appropriate or reserve all fund balance that is available for appropriation, regardless of classification.

- Section 5. The Board hereby refers to the financing sources and uses in the Recommended Budget and adopts the Budget as finally determined, resulting in the Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency Adopted Budget.
- Section 6. The Adopted Budget as finally determined meets the requirements set forth in Government Code Section 29089.
- Section 7. A copy of the Adopted Budget shall be filed by the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector in the office of the Clerk of the Board and the office of the State Controller not later than December 1, 2025.
- Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
