Updated Fee Ordinance and Regulations Relating to Electric Vehicle Charging Station Fees and Time Limits and Recreation and Park Fees

As part of the Countywide Vision to provide sustainable infrastructure, the County launched an Electric Vehicle Charging Initiative, adopted September 27, 2022.

The goal is to increase the capacity and availability of electric vehicle charging stations throughout the county for use by members of the public and County employees.

Proposed Fee

Bloomington Recreation and Park District will add two charging stations at Ayala Park, which include:

- \$0.32 per Kilowatthour, plus overstay fee.
- Ability to adjust charging station fees based on actual cost of electricity, not to exceed 25% of stated ordinance rate.

Other Recreation and Park Fees

Bloomington Recreation and Park District will add several fees for new recreational amenities and services, including:

- Fees for usage of new snack bar, new batting cages, and new “Dream Field”.
- Addition of Field Preparation fees, along with requirement of a deposit to cover any damages that may be incurred with field use.



OVERVIEW OF ORDINANCE

- Approves fees for the use of electric vehicle charging stations at Ayala Park.
- Adopts County Code to comply with State law related to parking violations.
- Establishes parking restrictions that only allow for electric and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles currently charging, to park in designated electric vehicle charging station parking stalls.
- Adds penalties for violations of restrictions.
- Adds a section for removal or towing of a vehicle in violation of County Code requirements applicable to parking lots.
- Adds fees for usage of new amenities, such as the snack bar, batting cages, and “Dream Field”.
- Adds fees for new task of field preparation, and corresponding deposit for field usage to pay for damages if necessary.



RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Make alterations, if necessary, to the proposed ordinances.
2. Approve introduction of proposed ordinances
 - An ordinance of the Bloomington Recreation and Park District to establish various recreation and park activity fees for Fiscal Year 2023-24 and to repeal Ordinance No. SD 23-03.
 - An ordinance of the Bloomington Recreation and Park District to adopt by reference Sections 52.0130, 53.0603, 53.0604, 53.0605, 53.0606, and 53.0607 of the San Bernardino County Code and add new regulations relating to electric vehicle charging station fees and time limits for District parking lots.
