SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors, acting as the governing body for County Service Area 70 Glen Helen, will consider adoption of a proposed ordinance relating to the availability of recycled water produced by the Lytle Creek North Wastewater Recycling Plant and regulates the distribution, permitted uses, and administration of recycled water service within the boundaries of County Service Area 70 Glen Helen.

Ordinance Summary

The proposed ordinance establishes the availability of recycled water produced by the Lytle Creek North Wastewater Recycling Plant and regulates the distribution, permitted uses, and administration of recycled water service within the boundaries of County Service Area 70 Glen Helen. The ordinance sets forth the County's authority to provide recycled water service, identifies the applicable service area, and establishes requirements governing recycled water use permits, operational controls, customer responsibilities, enforcement, and compliance with applicable state and federal recycled water laws and regulations. The ordinance further authorizes the County to administer, regulate, and enforce recycled water service, provides for the establishment of recycled water rates consistent with constitutional and statutory requirements, and includes provisions addressing inspection, enforcement, liability, and severability.
