On October 8, 2024 (Item No. 48), the Board of Supervisors (Board) acting as the governing body of the San Bernardino County Flood Control District and San Bernardino County, approved a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU No. 24-982) with the San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District regarding the potential recharge of State Water Project water at the Cactus Basins in Rialto.				
The MOU is effective from October 8, 2024, through October 7, 2025, with an option to extend for one additional year. In Recommendation No. 3 of the October 8, 2024, Board Agenda Item No. 48, the Board delegated authority to the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) to exercise the one year extension option. Recommendation No. 4 of the October 8, 2024, Board Agenda Item No. 48 directs the CEO to transmit the one-year extension of the Memorandum of Understanding to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors within 30 days of execution. This delegation ensures administrative efficiency and continuity in interagency collaboration without requiring further Board action.  The MOU establishes a framework for evaluating the feasibility, environmental impacts, and legal considerations of using the Cactus Basins, which are used for flood control management, for groundwater recharge when not needed for stormwater detention. The MOU does not authorize any specific project but allows the parties to explore the potential for recharge activities, including the development of an Adaptive Management Plan to address technical and regulatory concerns, particularly related to existing perchlorate contamination plumes in the Rialto-Colton Basin.
