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The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, State of California,  
ordains as follows:

(d) Pursuant to Health and Safety Code sections 5473 through 5473a, the County elects to have delinquent fees, and the related penalties and interest and costs of collection, collected on the tax roll in the same manner, by the same person, and at the same time as, together with but not separately from, its general taxes. This election shall remain in effect until June 30, 2035.

Except as otherwise allowed in sections 46.1401, 46.1402, 46.1403, and 45.1404, it shall be unlawful for any person to fail or refuse to subscribe or pay for uniform handling service implemented under this Chapter. Such a failure or refusal to subscribe or pay for required uniform handling service shall subject such person to the penalties provided in section 46.1601.

SECTION 3. Subsection 46.0604(h) of the San Bernardino County Code is amended to read as follows:

1 (h) The County may grant, on a case by case basis and subject to the  
2 discretion of the Director or the Director's designee, an exemption (which exemption  
3 may be revoked by the Director or the Director's designee upon 30 days written notice  
4 to business) to a business from compliance with this section for any of the following  
5 reasons:

6 (1) Lack of sufficient space in the business to provide additional  
7 organic waste recycling bins.

8 (2) The current implementation by a business of actions that result in  
9 the recycling of a significant portion of its organic waste.

10 (3) The business does not generate at least one-half of a cubic yard of  
11 organic waste per week.

12 (4) Limited-term exemptions for extraordinary or unforeseen events.

13 (5) Any other reason that is authorized by the State of California.  
14

15 SECTION 4. Subsection 46.1003(d) is amended to read as follows:


16 (d) The Director may delegate the duties under this Section to a designee.  
17 The decision of the Director or a designee shall be final on any matter of \$5,000.00 or  
18 less. In the event of a decision on a matter awarding more than \$5,000.00, grantee may  
19 seek review pursuant to the notice of appeal procedure contained in § 46.1001.

21 SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from the date of its
