Utilizing funds granted to the County for a shared project strengthens coordination with smaller agencies within the region and with remote agencies who would otherwise not have the financial ability to better guard themselves against possible terror threats. This is an ongoing project where years of data has been collected. As more information is collected, a broad picture of potential threats to the region is more identifiable, building on terrorism prevention.
