ORDINANCE NO. FPD 23-___

An ordinance of the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District to amend Ordinance No. FPD 23-02 and to establish fire service fees, fire suppression, emergency response and cost recovery fees, ambulance service and subscription fees.

The Board of Directors of the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District, County of San Bernardino, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The Board of Directors of the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District hereby finds and determines that:

- (a) The San Bernardino County Fire Protection District fee ordinance is submitted annually to its Board of Directors for approval. On April 25, 2023 (Item No. 76), the Board of Directors adopted Ordinance No. FPD 23-02 that, effective July 1, 2023, repeals Ordinance FPD 22-01, which are the fees for Fiscal Year 2022-23, and establishes fire service fees, fire suppression, emergency response and cost recovery fees, ambulance service and subscription fees for Fiscal Year 2023-24. Attachment A to Ordinance No. FPD 23-02 included the fees for Fiscal Year 2023-24.
- (b) It was discovered that Attachment A to Ordinance No. FPD 23-02 inadvertently listed eight employee classification hourly fees for Fiscal Year 2023-24 in Section H incorrectly due to a miscalculation of productive hours.
- (c) The intent of this ordinance is to amend Ordinance No. FPD 23-02 by adopting a revised Attachment A, attached hereto, in order to:
- (i) Correct eight employee classification hourly fees for Fiscal Year 2023-24 as identified in Section H of Attachment A to Ordinance No. FPD 23-02; and
- (ii) Make the following revisions to Section H of Attachment A to Ordinance No. FPD 23-02: the deletion of an extra dollar symbol; removal of the phrase "Community Safety" from the title of "Deputy Fire Marshal" to be consistent with the employee classification title; and the inclusion of the Deputy Fire Marshal rate

Section M - Waiver/Refund of Fees:

- This Section M is effective the date the Ordinance is effective. In the (1) event of a disaster, or other good cause shown to serve a public purpose, the Fire Chief may defer payment of, waive, or refund any fee set forth in this Ordinance or any other fee levied by County Fire provided all of the following conditions are met:
 - Exigent conditions exist whereby obtaining Board of Directors approval of the fee waiver/refund/deferral would not be immediately feasible: and
 - County Fire receives concurrence from its Chief Executive Officer. b)
- Except as otherwise provided by law, the Board of Directors, by Board (2) action, can defer payment of, waive, or refund any fee set forth in this Ordinance or any other fee levied by County Fire provided one of the following conditions is met:
 - The service for which the fee was levied has not and will not be performed, or

- (B) The fee was collected in error, or
- (C) For other good cause shown, provided such waiver/refund would serve a public purpose.
- (3) Notwithstanding (1) and (2) of this Section M, the Fire Chief may refund:
 - (A) Any fee collected in error or that results in an overpayment, and/or
 - (B) Unused deposit monies on actual cost projects when all charges for the project have been recorded.

Note: Pursuant to Government Code section 29375.1, the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District shall not be required to issue a refund of \$10.00 or less.
