This Amendment No. 2 (“Amendment”) to the underlying Memorandum of Understanding No. M-045-25 (“MOU”) is by and between the **SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS** (“SCAG”) and the **SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY**, subsequently herein referred to as the “Sub-Recipient,” for the **Regional Utilities Supporting Housing (“RUSH”) Program Grant** (“Project”) under the REAP 2.0 funding (“Program”). SCAG and the Sub-Recipient are individually referred to herein as “Party” and may be collectively referred to herein as “Parties.”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the MOU dated May 15, 2025, and

WHEREAS, SECTION 11 of the MOU permits the Parties to amend the MOU through written amendment; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of Amendment No. 2 (“Amendment 2”) is to amend Section 4 Project Management, Section 5 Funding, and the Project Budget from Exhibit A Scope of Work.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

1. Section 4 (Project Management) Sub-section (b) is amended to read:

2. Section 5 (Funding) Sub-section (a) is amended to read:

- a. SCAG's contribution to the Project is funded wholly with REAP 2.0 funds, in an amount not to exceed \$4,055,791.00 ("Grant Funds").

3. Exhibit A (Scope of Work) is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with Exhibit A-1 attached hereto, and incorporated herein by this reference.

In all other respects, the terms and conditions of the MOU, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

Exhibit A-1 – Scope of Work

Project Name: Bloomington Sewer Extension

Project Description: The Bloomington Sewer Extension Project implemented by San Bernardino County extends the existing sewer infrastructure within the Bloomington community to support future housing development and includes the installation of sewer mainline, manholes, and sewer tie-ins. The project will expand utility service to serve housing needs in the community and advance resilience by extending the existing sewer infrastructure within the Bloomington community so that the centralized sewer system can support existing and diverse future housing developments. The project includes the following: approximately 2,600 linear feet of 12” sewer main lines; and 24 manholes; connection of new sewer main lines to the existing trunk line on Valley Boulevard; and corresponding design, construction, and construction administration.
